Project Description

This project consists of installing new water lines along portions of Chapel Rd. and Old Lorena Rd. This project is one of several projects aimed at replacing undersized water lines and installing new water lines along portions of Warren Rd., Spring Valley Rd., Old Lorena Rd., Chapel Rd. and Ritchie Rd.

Project History

The City of Waco recently began providing service to the area west of Hewitt. Based on 2040 water model results, the exiting infrastructure is not adequately sized to serve growth. The proposed water lines will supply surface water to this area and allow the City of Waco to return control of the local water well owned by the City of Hewitt.

Community Benefit

This project ensures safe and reliable water service, with consistent water pressure, in a developing area of McLennan County.
